

GTLI's Transition Back to Campus

Frequently Asked Questions

Am I required to attend the face-to-face meeting days?

Face-to-face meeting days will be optional but strongly encouraged in the Summer 2021 IEP session. Full 100% face-to-face attendance will be required beginning in the Fall 1 IEP session.

How will I know when my class meets face-to-face or live remotely?

The instructor of your courses will communicate course meeting locations each week at the beginning of the IEP session.

What if I have classes at different levels?

A student taking courses at multiple levels might find that they have a mix of face-to-face and live remote classes on the same day. Lab space will be available for use by GTLI students to 'attend' live remote versions of their courses online. Students must bring their own laptop, headset with microphone, and charger to utilize the lab space. This equipment will not be provided during the Summer 2021 IEP.
